SUMMER COURSE

This is a request form to enroll in Sabine’s Online Academic Program. This request form requires that both parents and students sign that they understand and accept the district’s/school’s terms for taking an on-line course.

- Sabine Online is a full-time academically accredited program for students enrolled in Sabine Parish beginning in the 2020-2021 school year.
- Sabine Online students will be full-time Sabine Parish students enrolled in online classes taught by Louisiana certified teachers and online teaching experts.
- EdOptions, in partnership with Sabine Parish Schools, provides certified teachers, administrators, counselors, and special education staff. The online curricula and instructional model is developed and provided through EdOptions in partnership with Sabine Parish Schools. The assigned teacher will determine course structure, grading deadlines and requirements, and implementation of courses/classes.
- Parents/Students have 12 days after the start of classes to withdraw from the online program and return to the campus setting. After the 12-day deadline, K-12 students must complete the semester before opting into the campus setting. Falling behind in the assigned work is not a reason for an immediate change in setting. Parents are encouraged and expected to monitor their student’s progress in on-line courses/classes.
- Sabine Parish Schools will provide the student with a device (Chromebook) and technical support.
- Internet access will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian. SPSB currently offers wireless Internet at school sites and is working towards other wireless locations across the district.
- District/school/EdOptions staff, students, and parents will work together to support student learning.
- Teachers may provide synchronous (live video and audio) and asynchronous (recorded lessons). Teachers will have daily office hours for phone calls or live video hours for students or parents to request help or clarification concerning assignments.
- The on-line courses/classes/schedules will be based on student needs, grade level, course needs, and graduation requirements.
- Students will be responsible for completing their assigned work as directed by the teacher. Students may not assist other students with online work unless authorized by the teacher.
- Student behavior in the online class will be appropriate behavior for any class. The student will be focused and working on classwork, silent, not distracting to others, respectful to other students and respectful to the teacher.
- Inappropriate behavior will be reported to the school principal.
- Repeated behavioral issues may result in the student being denied permission to take other on-line classes. This includes not staying current with the on-line work and plagiarism of work.
- The teacher will verify when a student has completed a course/class.
- Students who do not work on their courses and give the false impression of doing so may fall behind and receive an F for the course.
- Student schedules are determined by grade-level promotion and graduation requirements.

- The student must have all required signatures on this form before approved for Sabine Online Academic Program.
- Students who violate these terms will lose the opportunity to take other on-line classes in the future.
- LHSAA (Louisiana High School Athletic Association) determines athletic eligibility is determined by. As of June 2020, LHSAA requires in-person attendance to participate in athletics.
- Participation in clubs governed by National and State organizations is subject to the organizational guidelines.
- Participation in school and district clubs is allowed.
