Creating a Plan for School Improvement

The key components of our plan that will lead to school improvement include:

- An improved, standards-aligned curriculum for students that meets the criteria to be the highest rated curriculum in the state
- Training for our teachers on the use of this curriculum

Plan to improve Science and Social Studies

- ELA Content Leaders will provide professional development on ELA strategies (accountable talk, vocabulary displays, semantic maps, gallery walk) and writing strategies.
- Devote PLC time for intentional planning around Science/Social Studies units. Provide time for the teachers to plan! Create slides to teach content and plan ways to involve community.
- Interventions: DRC, iXL, Scholastic Magazines

Plan to improve ELA/Math

- ELA and Math Content Leaders provide professional development
- ELA Interventions: ELA support for Diverse Learners, Writing Revolution LEAP 360

Given the data we've shared, Many Jr. High School is focused on the following priorities for the 2020-2021 school year:

- 2020-2021 State Subgroup School Wide Data by May 2021, students at each grade level will meet higher standard in all content areas by attaining proficiency or better on the LEAP 2025 assessment.
- 2020-2021 state ELA test results, by May 2021, students at each grade level will meet higher standards in ELA by attaining proficiency or better on the LEAP 2025 assessment.
- 2020-2021 state Math test results, by May 2021, students at each grade level will meet higher standards in Math by attaining proficiency or better on the LEAP 2025
- 2020-2021 state Science/Social Studies test results, by May 2021, students at each grade level will meet higher standards in Science/Social Studies by attaining proficiency or better on the LEAP 2025
